This Saturday, June 19 is the date that has been set for the 15th Annual Run/Walk for the Church. This fundraiser will benefit not only our parish here in South River, but also Christ the Saviour Church in Paramus and Annunciation Church in Brick. Parishioners of all ages are encouraged to take part in this fun and fellowship-building day. We've had a great time in the past and are looking forward to an even better one this time!

This year's family-friendly trek will begin around 11:30 a.m. and again start and finish in South River. The distance will be about nine miles for runners and five miles for walkers.
