**IN MEMORIUM** His Eminence, **Metropolitan JOHN of Nicaea**, retired former Archbishop of Karelia and All Finland, fell asleep in the Lord on Thursday, July 1. He served as Primate of the Finnish Church from 1987 until his voluntary resignation in 2001, at which time he was named Metropolitan of Nicaea, a titular See of the Patriarchate of Constantinople. Metropolitan JOHN was a theologian, translator, author and internationally renowned expert in Canon Law. He participated in various ecumenical endeavors and received numerous church and civil awards. While his views were often criticized, he will be remembered by the Finnish faithful as a “caring and respected shepherd.” May his memory be eternal—Vechnaya Pamyat!
