On days when Divine Liturgy is served, the Third Hour prayers begin approximately 10-15 minutes prior. From that point on, there should be **no talking**. We should also be quiet and reverent during Holy Communion, the sermon and the announcements at the end of Liturgy. Conversation should also be limited while exiting the church after venerating the Cross. Remember that the church is a place of

IN MEMORIUM The primate of the Midwestern Diocese of the Serbian Orthodox Church of North America, His Eminence, Metropolitan CHRISTOPHER, fell asleep in the Lord this past Wednesday, August 18. He was recently diagnosed with both bone and brain cancer, for which he was undergoing treatment. His Beatitude, Metropolitan JONAH, was to have visited His Eminence just a few days ago, in conjunction with an archpastoral visit to Holy Trinity Church in Clayton, WI and his attendance at the Annual Clergy Conference of the Diocese of the Midwest. Metropolitan CHRISTOPHER was the first American-born bishop to serve a diocese of the Serbian Church in North America. He developed a diocesan-wide program in religious education and assisted his parishes to become bilingual in their worship. Our hearts go out to our Serbian brothers and sisters in their time of sorrow. His Eminence believed in his priestly vocation and lived it generously and for that, he is most worthy of eternal life in God's heavenly kingdom. May his memory be eternal—Vechnaya Pamyat!
